Currently...

The number of new dentists practicing in the County has increased in the past 6 years.

Hence, the need for educated, well trained dental office employees has increased due to greater number of dentists. Many of them would like an EFDA or 2 to work with them...

Expanded Functions Dental Auxiliary (EFDA)

* To become an EFDA, you first must be a CDA (Certified Dental Assistant)

Sit for the exam through DANB (Dental Assisting National Board)

Dental Assistants in Maine

- * Can be trained chair side
- * Can be trained in a dental assisting program
- * DANB (Dental Assisting National Board)
- * Provides examinations to acquire certification (Certified Dental Assistant or CDA)
- * "next level" is EFDA (Expanded Functions Dental Auxiliary) licensure
- * Became a licensed position in Maine in 2008 and training programs were developed

Where is Training Available?

- * A majority of the best candidates for the CDA and EFDA training are already employed
- * Programs take this into consideration and provide training on Friday afternoons and Saturdays
- * Still, traveling outside of the County after a full week of work (many work 9 hr days, M-Th), is considerably "inconvenient"

NMCC/St Apollonia Dental Clinic Partnership

- * Program offered "locally"
- * Students appreciate having the training "at home" in the County
- * Most of the funding for this pilot is provided by the
- **Healthcare Sector Grant and**
 - **Northern Maine AHEC**



Dental Assisting Training Details

- * First group of 8 students selected from pool of applicants
- * Extremely quick timeline (April 2013 – June 2013!)
- * Equipment, curriculum development and "infrastructure" will allow for sustainability and growth



8 students, scheduled to sit for certification
